## 2009 Education Challenge General Rules

- 1) Winning Educators from each state will be determined by highest number of documented, qualified hours from June 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009. The 2008-09 Education Challenge is open only to FACS Educators and Baby Lock Loaner Program Educators in the states of Arkansas, Missouri and Oklahoma. Educators compete against educators from their own state. Each educator's state is determined by their school address, not home address. B•Sew Inn's Education Division will have complete discretion to settle disputes arising due to address changes and/or location.
- 2) Challenge Hours must be completed by the educator, not by students. Students may assist in the learning process. Workbook lessons completed during classroom time qualify provided that the educator was wholly involved, not just observing or assisting students.
- 3) Workbook lessons must be completed on the equipment that the workbook was written for. Example: Baby Lock Evolve Workbook Lessons must be stitched out on the Baby Lock Evolve Serger. Workbook lessons require documentation that must be submitted according to specifications. All documentation must be new work, completed during the current term and not entered in a previous Challenge year. This means that Sew @ Home On-Line classes will only qualify for one Challenge Period if they are taken in the month of June 2008. If you turned them in for last year's Challenge don't turn them in for the 2009 Challenge.
- 4) Submission of documented hours is the responsibility of the educator. B•Sew Inn Education Division will assist in the tracking of Baby Lock Equipment Loaner Participation Hours, Education Division Workshop Hours. All other hours must be submitted by the educator on the official tracking sheets. Verification of these additional hours will be made prior to acceptance. Submission in a timely fashion is suggested. To assist in this process you can download pdf file "Education Challenge Tracker Sheet" from our website.
- 5) In the event of a tie, up to 10 Bonus Hours can be awarded by B-Sew Inn Education Division for quality and neatness of work. If a tie still remains after such an award, the winner will be determined by drawing.
- 6) Winning Educators will be announced at the 2009 Summer Conferences for each participating state or by website/email if State Conference schedules conflict.
